

Key Investor Information

This document provides you with key investor information about this fund. It is not marketing material. The information is required by law to help you understand the nature and the risks of investing in this fund. You are advised to read it so you can make an informed decision about whether to invest.

Stability (the "Sub-Fund") is a sub-fund of Long Term Investment Fund (SIA) (the "Fund") Class A CAP CHF (the "Class") - ISIN: LU1589813515

The Fund has appointed FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A. as management company.

Objectives and investment policy

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to provide long-term capital appreciation, primarily through investment in a select portfolio of worldwide equities and occasionally in some debt securities. To achieve this, the investment manager will attempt to hold volatility low while providing a healthy net return clearly above basic interest rates over the medium term.

The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The benchmark index of the Sub-Fund is the HFRX Global Hedge Fund Index CHF. It is mentioned only for performance comparison purposes. The Sub-Fund does not track the index and can deviate significantly or entirely from the benchmark index.

The Sub-Fund will seek to have an exposure to equities, equity related securities and debt securities (including money market instruments). In order to achieve its objective, the Sub-Fund will mainly invest directly in the securities mentioned in the previous paragraph; and/ or in undertakings for collective investment (UCIs) having as main objective to invest or grant an exposure to the above-mentioned asset classes; and/ or in any transferable securities (structured products, as described in the prospectus) linked or offering an exposure to the performance of the above-mentioned securities.

Investment risk will be spread by preserving a neutral bias, hence there will apply no restrictions as to specific currency, sector or regional weights (including emerging markets). However, depending on financial market conditions, a particular focus can be placed in a single country (or some countries) and/ or in a single currency and/ or in a single economic sector. The Sub-Fund may also invest in structured products, as further detailed in the prospectus, including structured products without embedded derivatives, correlated with changes in commodities (including precious metals) with cash settlement. These investments may not be used to elude the investment policy of the Sub-Fund.

The Sub-Fund may also invest up to 10% of its net assets in other open-ended undertakings for collective investment. Within the limits specified

in the prospectus, the Sub-Fund may invest in Russia, through among others securities listed on the MICEX-RTS.

If the investment manager considers this to be in the best interest of the shareholders, the Sub-Fund may also, on a temporary basis, hold, up to 100% of its net assets, liquidities as among others cash deposits, money market funds (within the 10% limit in funds) and money market instruments.

For hedging and for any other purposes, the Sub-Fund may use financial derivative instruments within the limits and descriptions set out in the prospectus. The use of derivative instrument may increase leverage, imply additional costs and risks.

Dealing Frequency

The net asset value for this Class is calculated every bank business day in Luxembourg. The cut-off time to submit subscription and/or redemption orders is 4 p.m. Luxembourg time on the last business day preceding the relevant valuation day.

Distribution Policy

The Class is cumulative. No dividend will normally be distributed.

Currency

The currency of the Class is CHF.

Investment Horizon

The Sub-Fund is a medium risk vehicle aiming to provide capital growth. It may be suitable for investors seeking prudent balanced diversification, combining mainly equity and some debt market exposure. The recommended investment horizon is 3 to 5 years.

Why is this Sub-Fund in this category?

The portfolio of this Sub-Fund consists essentially of equities or equity related securities issued worldwide. Besides, the Investment Manager systematically applies an active hedging strategy, which tries to achieve outperformance and to immunize the portfolio against the global share market movements. Therefore its risk/reward profile corresponds to a volatility which is somewhat lower than the underlying volatility of the worldwide equity market. This profile indicates the investment to carry a high level of risk.

Are there any other particular Risks?

- **Liquidity risks:** The Sub-Fund may invest part of its assets in less liquid securities. Those are securities that cannot easily be sold or exchanged for cash without a substantial loss in value in certain market conditions. Those securities also cannot be sold quickly because of a lack of ready and willing investors or speculators to purchase the asset.
- **Counterparty risks:** The Sub-Fund can conclude various transactions with contractual partners. If a contractual partner becomes insolvent,

it can no longer or can only partly settle unpaid debts owed to the Sub-Fund.

- **Credit risks:** The Sub-Fund may invest a portion of its assets in debt securities. The issuers of these debt securities may become insolvent, which will mean that the securities will lose all or some of their value.
- **Risks from the use of derivatives:** The Sub-Fund may use financial derivatives instruments which may result in the Sub-Fund being leveraged and may result in material fluctuations in the value of the Sub-Fund. Leverage on certain types of transactions including derivatives may impair the Sub-Fund's liquidity, cause it to liquidate positions at unfavourable times or otherwise cause the Sub-Fund not to achieve its intended objective.

Leverage occurs when the economic exposure created by the use of derivatives is greater than the amount invested resulting in the Sub-Fund being exposed to a greater loss than the initial investment.

- **Operational risks:** The Sub-Fund may fall victim to fraud or criminal acts. It may suffer losses as a result of misunderstandings or mistakes by employees of the Management Company or by external third parties or may be damaged by external events, such as natural disasters.

The percentage of ongoing charges is based on the last year's expenses, ending 31/12/2019. This figure may vary from year to year. It excludes:

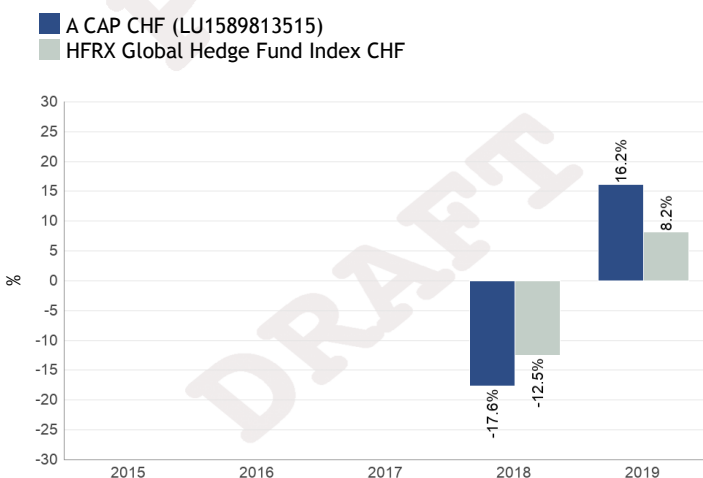
- Performance fees (if applicable)
- Portfolio transaction costs, except in the case of an entry/exit charge paid by the Sub-Fund when buying or selling units in another collective investment undertaking.

For the last financial year, the performance fee charged to the Class was 0.11% of the average annual net assets of the Class.

In case of a conversion request, a conversion commission of up to 1% of the net asset value of the shares of the Class into which conversion is requested may be charged by the Fund at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Fund.
